GRAPHIC MAKING BIG IMPRESSION ON NZ STAYING RANKS

From maiden winner to Group 2 Wellington Cup hero in just three months, and a Dunstan Championship title thrown in between for good measure, talented galloper Graphic has more than made his presence felt on the New Zealand staying ranks this Summer. Somewhat of the new



kid on the block despite his five-year-old age tag, Graphic scored his maiden win in October with just two raceday outings under his belt, and then promptly illustrated his galloping ability with four subsequent wins, culminating in January's 2400m cup success at Trentham.

"He's come such a long way in a short time and he is just one of those horses who copes with every step up" said co-trainer Chad Ormsby following Graphic's Wellington Cup win.

"It was only his eight raceday appearance and what a great result for everyone involved".

Top of the list of those "involved" are Graphic's owner/breeders and long-time Ballymore clients, Chris and Susanna Grace.

"Chris and Susanna have been long time clients and friends of Ballymore Stables, and it was wonderful to see the Grace/Ballymore owner/trainer combination to the fore once again on the racetrack" said Ormsby. "Chris told me after the Cup win that he estimates that has won more than 170 races as an owner, but never a Wellington Cup, so Graphic's win was a real high point for them".

Interestingly, it is likely that it won't be until Graphic is a six-year-old that Chris and Susanna see their Wellington Cup winner again on raceday.

"Mike and I decided pretty much straight after the Cup that he would go for a spell and we'll bring him back for the Spring," said co-trainer Chad Ormsby.

"Time was always going to be his best friend and we are in no doubt that he'll come back from some time off as a more mature horse. We are prepared to wait for him. There's plenty more to come from this horse for sure".

Chris now races the talented filly Divissima as part of the Ballymore Ladies Syndicate and she has also recruited her sister and two friends to join in with the fun.


